

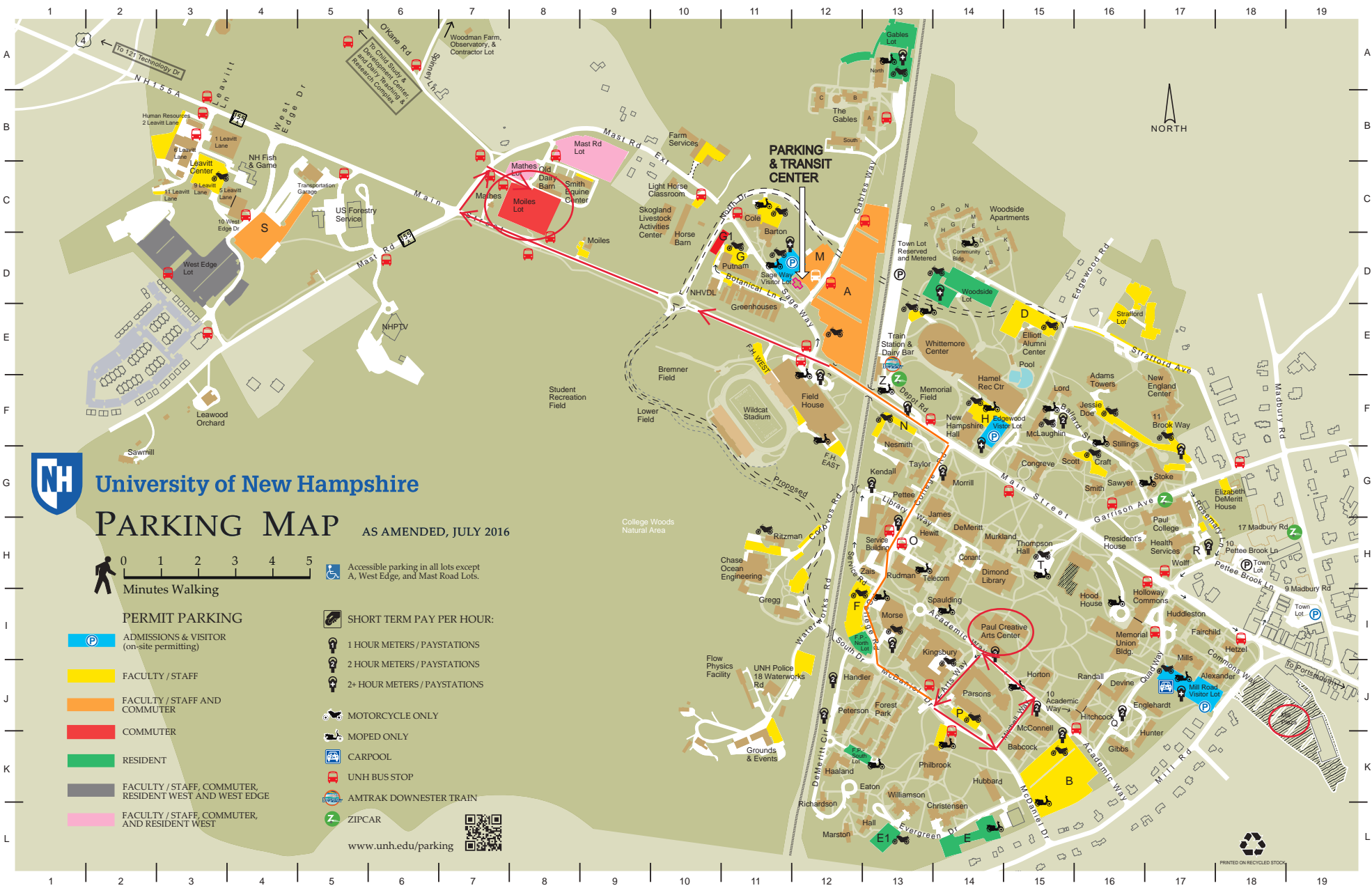
2017 UNH Band Extravaganza

GENERAL INFORMATION

- **Performances** of the Band Extravaganza will be presented at 9:00 a.m., 10:30 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. in Johnson Theater and will run approximately 50 minutes.
- **Seating** will begin 30 minutes prior to each performance. Please allow at least 30 minutes for drop-off, walking, restrooms, and seating.
- **Lunch** will not be provided. There are a few fast-food restaurants at the Lee traffic circle (take Rt. 4 W for about 2.5 miles) for larger groups, and a number of restaurants in downtown Durham for smaller groups. Further directions can be obtained at the Band Extravaganza.
- **Some UNH Band souvenirs** will be available in the lobby. Cash will be accepted, as well as checks made out to “UNH Music Department.”
- **Information about UNH, the Department of Music, and the various ensembles** will be available in the lobby.
- **Admission** to the Band Extravaganza is \$3 per person. You will be charged for the number registered by November 3rd. Changes to numbers can be made prior to November 3rd. Cash or checks may be used, with checks made payable to “UNH Music Department” and will be collected upon your arrival. Receipts will be available. PLEASE NOTE THESE CHANGES FROM 2016.

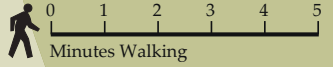
DIRECTIONS/PARKING INFORMATION

- **Johnson Theatre** is located in the Paul Creative Arts Center at 30 Academic Way. At the left end of the building (as you look at it), walk down the sidewalk that leads down the hill toward the Johnson Theatre lobby. Enter the lobby to check in.
- **Parking for visitor cars & vans** (not buses) is available by the visitor’s center. Permits are \$8 at the Visitor’s Center lots or \$1 per hour at a visitor’s center meter. Go into the visitor’s center with your license plate number to get your reserved parking permit.
- **Parking for buses** is in the Moiles Lot (formerly Mast Road Lot #2), and is free of charge for buses. Buses do not require a permit.
- **Cars & vans, drop-off & pick-up at the theater:** Drivers of cars and vans who may be dropping off and picking up students at the theatre can pull over into the fire lane, but may only remain in these zones long enough to pick up or drop off. This area is a highly congested. Please drop off quickly and proceed immediately with your car/van to the visitor’s center parking lot. Observe all posted signs!
- **Buses, drop-off & pick-up:** Buses are to drop off students and pick up students in front of the Paul Creative Arts Center. Please take care not to block traffic. After drop-off, buses should proceed immediately to the authorized parking lot, Moiles Lot. Buses are not permitted to stay in front of the PCAC. Each performance should last approximately 50 minutes.
- **Directions to the Paul Creative Arts Center:** Take Rt. 4 to Durham. Take the exit for Rt. 155A toward UNH. At light, turn right onto College Rd. Turn left onto Mitchell Way, and then left on Academic Way. This will bring you to the front of the Paul Creative Arts Center. Buses may drop off here and proceed to parking (there is no parking here).
- **If driving to Moiles Lot (Bus Parking):** After dropping off at the PCAC, turn left onto Arts Way, then take a right at the stop sign. Go to stop light and turn left onto Main St. Pass greenhouses and barns and turn right onto Mast Rd. Turn right into Moiles Lot.
