

# **2023 UNH Band Extravaganza**

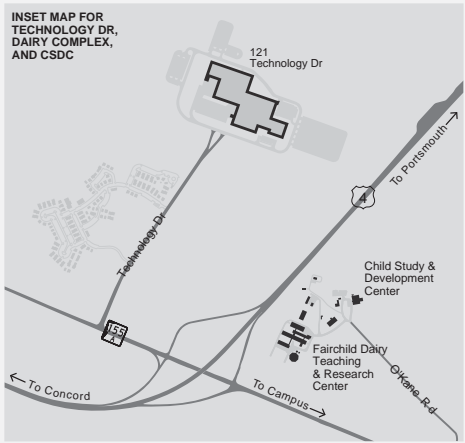
## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- **Performances** of the Band Extravaganza will be presented at 9 a.m., 10:30 a.m., and noon in Johnson Theatre and will run approximately 60 minutes each.
- **Seating** will begin 30 minutes prior to each performance. Please allow at least 30 minutes for drop-off, walking, restrooms, and seating.
- **Admission** to the Band Extravaganza is \$5 per person. You will be charged for the number registered by November 1. Changes to numbers can be made prior to then. Checks can be made payable to “UNH Music Department.” We are unable to accept cash. Payment will be collected upon your arrival if not mailed in advance. Receipts will be provided via email.
- **Lunch** will not be provided. There are a few fast-food restaurants at the Lee traffic circle (take Rt. 4 W for about 2.5 miles) for larger groups, and several restaurants in downtown Durham for smaller groups. Some groups have contacted [UNH Dining](#) to make group arrangements in the past at (603) 862-1821.
- **Some UNH Band souvenirs** may be available in the lobby. Cash will be accepted, as well as checks made out to “UNH Music Department.”
- **Information about UNH, the Department of Music, and the various ensembles** will be available in the lobby.

## **DIRECTIONS/PARKING INFORMATION**

- **Johnson Theatre** is located in the Paul Creative Arts Center at 30 Academic Way. At the left end of the building (as you look at it), walk down the sidewalk that leads down the hill toward the Johnson Theatre lobby. Enter the lobby to check in.
- **Buses, drop-off & pick-up:** **Reminder: BUSES MAY NOT LOAD/UNLOAD ON ACADEMIC WAY. PLEASE LOAD/UNLOAD ON MITCHELL WAY.** There have been issues in the past with buses blocking traffic in front of the PCAC so campus police no longer allow pick-up and drop off there. We thank you for your cooperation.
- **Parking for buses** is in the Moiles Lot (formerly Mast Road Lot #2) and is free of charge for buses. Buses do not require a permit.
- **Cars & vans, drop-off & pick-up at the theater:** Drivers of cars and vans who may be dropping off and picking up students at the theatre can pull over into the fire lane but may remain in these zones only long enough to pick up or drop off. This area is highly congested. Please drop off quickly and proceed immediately with your car/van to the visitor’s parking lot. Observe all posted signs!
- **Parking for visitor cars & vans** (not buses) is available in the various visitors’ lots on campus with pay and display meters. Cost is \$1.50/hour at the Sage Way Visitor’s Lot and \$1.75/hour at the Edgewood Rd. and Campus Crossing Visitor’s Lots. - **Directions to the Paul Creative Arts Center:** Address is 30 Academic Way, Durham, NH which should work with any GPS. It is recommended to approach via Mill Rd., turn down Academic Way, and then turn left on Mitchell Way. This will allow buses to drop off on the sidewalk that connects to a crosswalk in front of the Paul Creative Arts Center.
- **If driving to Moiles Lot (Bus Parking):** After dropping off on Mitchell Way turn right at the stop sign. Go to stop light and turn left onto Main St. Pass the greenhouses and barns and turn right onto Mast Rd. Turn right into Moiles Lot.
